Fellows Program

The Economic Club of New York (ECNY) Fellows Program is a customized year-long program that introduces rising executives with great promise to thoughtful discussions and debates on the complex issues of the day, ranging from pressing economic, social and political issues, public policy questions and corporate reporting issues to economic regulation and tech disruption, and much more. All Fellows must be sponsored by a Club Member in good standing.

The exclusive Fellows-only programming includes intimate events with prominent Executives who are Members of the Club who share their personal business insights in an open-discussion format, virtual networking (and in-person networking when it is safe to do so) within the Fellows Class, and complimentary access to all virtual member events. Fellows can network and enjoy attendance at occasional Club signature events where a special table is reserved for them. Fellows are given the opportunity to ask the first question(s) to the Guest Speaker at the Club's Breakfast Series. Additional programming includes an Economic Jeopardy competition and a community volunteer opportunity. At the end of the program, the Fellows are recognized by the entire membership and will become a member of the Alumni Network with additional networking opportunities. Upon completion of the program, Fellows will possess many new insights and a broader network to expand their leadership impact and are offered the opportunity to become a Member of the Club.

- Are rising executives in leadership roles
- Have approximately 7-15 year's experience with an impressive performance history
- Are interested in a broad range of business sectors
- Reside and/or work in New York Metro Area
- Have a significant educational background
- Women and diverse candidates are encouraged

Fellows may apply with the support of Member sponsor(s) to the Membership Committee for Associate Membership or Full Club Membership depending on their seniority and accomplishments to date.
